

1. Battery - To check your battery swipe left to right from the home screen. (If you don't see the battery widget, scroll down, tap edit band press the + symbol next to the battery icon).

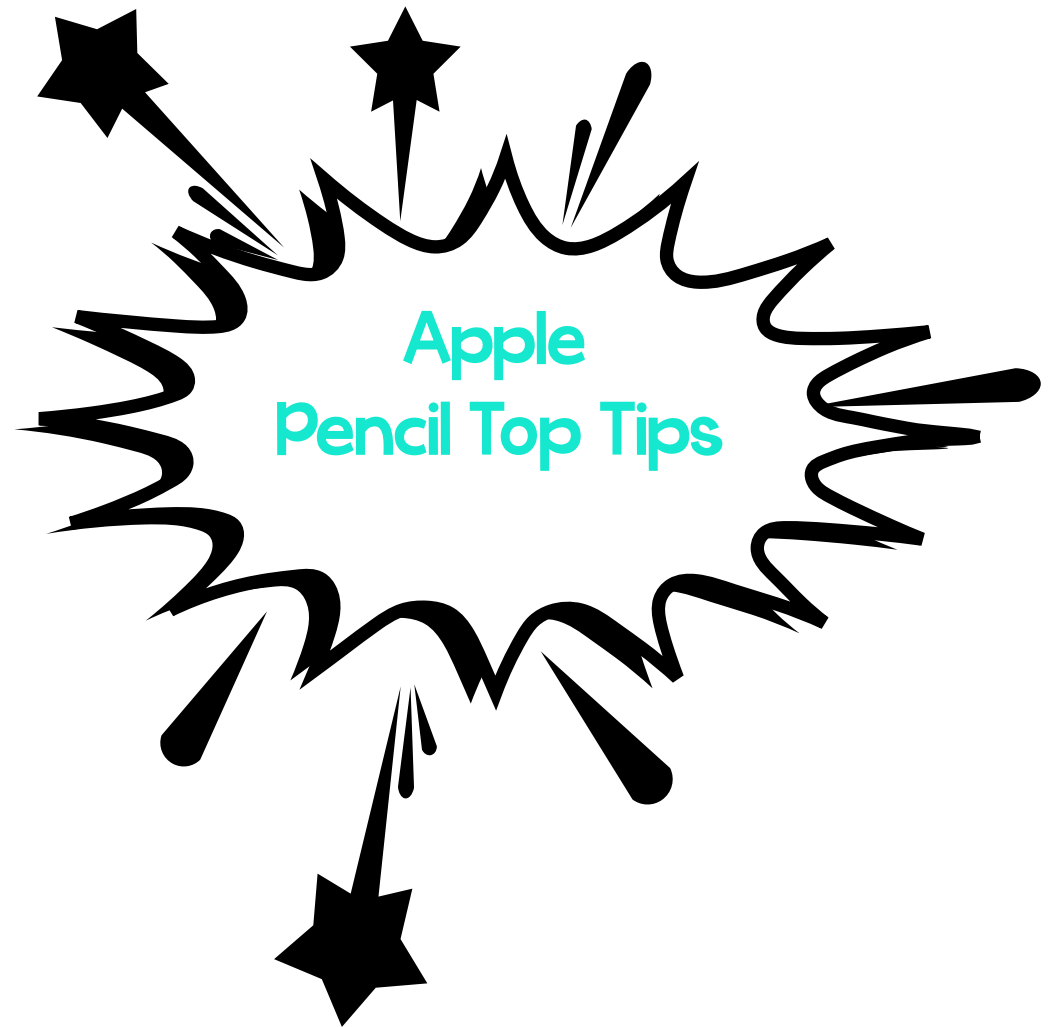
2. Screen shot - To take a screen shot swipe into the centre from either the left or right corner (you instantly have mark up tools).

3. 'Quick note' - Tap once on the lock screen and NOTES instantly opens.

4. Sign here - To create a signature with Apple Pencil, swipe up from the bottom corner of the screen. Tap + in the Markup toolbar, choose Signature, sign your name, then tap Done. The next time you need a signature, tap + in the toolbar of a supported app, then tap Signature.

5. Trace through Paper - Place any picture or book page on top of the ipad and draw over using your pencil - magic!

6. Slide to Shade - Draw on the screen with the side of the Apple Pencil nib. This angle creates a shade effect, as if you were shading in with a regular pencil. Don't worry about resting your palm against the screen when sketching either. The iPad features a new palm-rejection technology that detects which part of your hand is resting on the screen and ignores it where necessary.



7. Pages, Numbers and Keynote - In Pages, tap and hold with the pencil to create a box, resize it to your requirements and draw. You can paste your drawing into a Keynote presentation, and animate it, so it's redrawn on the fly. You can also use the Apple Pencil to write on a Numbers spreadsheet.
